

Dear CADA Family

This letter is to inform you of what to do if your child or anyone in your household develops any symptoms of coronavirus and the steps that the Academy have in place to support you.

It is important that your child does not come to the Academy if:

- They have symptoms of Covid-19
- Anyone in their household has symptoms of Covid-19
- They have returned from a country on the government Travel restriction website

What are the symptoms of Covid-19?

The symptoms to look out for are:

A new continuous cough

- Coughing a lot for more than an hour or 3 or more episodes in 24 hours

A loss of taste or smell

- Cannot smell/taste, or things smell/taste different to normal

A high temperature or fever

- Hot to touch on chest or back

What to do if your child develops symptoms:

At the Academy:

If your child develops symptoms whilst in class, we will sensitively isolate them in the Kitchen which is only being used as a Holding Room. You will be asked to come and collect immediately.

At home:

If your child develops symptoms at home, you should not send them to the Academy. Please inform us of the absence and let us know that you suspect the symptoms are those of Covid-19.

What happens next?

- In both the above cases your child should then isolate at home.
- You should book a Covid-19 test for your child – where possible - and let us know the results as soon as possible.
- Members of your household should also isolate.

Test results and next actions

Positive Results (your child has Covid-19)

- If the results are positive you will need to continue to isolate your child for 10 days
- Members of your household will need to isolate for 14 days from the date of the first symptoms.

Negative results (your child does not have Covid-19)

- If the results are negative your child and your household can stop isolating immediately.
- Your child can then return to the Academy when they are feeling better.

What to do if someone in your household has symptoms of Covid-19

If someone in your household or within your support bubble has Covid-19 symptoms you will need to isolate your child and they should not come to class.

We advise that the person with symptoms should then look to take a test as soon as possible.

If the result is negative your child can return to CADA.

If the result is positive your child will need to isolate for 14 days from the date that your household member first had symptoms.
